**Program Description**

**Overview:**

Attendees will acquire skills to implement the new NLN Educational Outcomes and Competencies into North Carolina nursing programs.

- Dr. Field will present an overview of the NLN Educational Competencies framework.
- The three templates which were developed by Dr. Field, her faculty, and two national consultants will be presented and shared electronically with the attendees.
- Dr. Field will explain how to develop a clinical portfolio which systematically links assignments to the course objectives and to the student learner outcomes.
- Two of the integrating concepts of the NLN framework are Quality and Safety and Teamwork. Dr. Field will share how her faculty implemented the Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality (AHRQ) TeamSTEPPS program into their nursing program to teach teamwork, and used the Institute of Healthcare Improvement (IHI) to implement Safety and Quality Improvement tutorials into their nursing program.

Upon completion of the workshop, participants will be able to:

1. Contrast program learner outcomes of the NLN framework to their individual program learner outcomes.
2. Identify a resource to integrate the core values of the NLN Educational Competencies Model into nursing programs.
3. Demonstrate skills to implement the integrating concepts of the NLN Educational Competencies Model into nursing programs.
4. Evaluate course objectives which reflect the three apprenticeships of the integrating concepts of the NLN framework.
5. Identify a method to facilitate faculty group involvement in the implementation of the NLN framework.
6. Examine how a clinical/program portfolio can demonstrate the accomplishment of student learner outcomes.
7. Analyze tools to implement TeamSTEPPS throughout a nursing program.
8. Identify learning activities to implement the Institute of Health Care Improvement (IHI) Open School learning tutorials.
